## WORKING REMOTELY IN ALASKA

- Alaska has an unemployment rate of around 6.0%, which is above the national average of 3.6%. (Bureau of Labor Statistics [BLS] EaG, Jan. 2020)
- The unemployment rate is highly susceptible to fluctuations because of low population, seasonal employment, and regional factors.
- Providence Health & Services is Alaska's largest employer with more than 4,000 full- and part-time employees. (Providence Health & Services)
- The projected job growth rate in Alaska is 0.3% as of January 2020. (Alaska Dept. of Labor & Workforce Development, Jan. 2020)
- Alaska's annual mean wage is \$58,710 for all occupations. (BLS Occupational Employment Statistics, May 2018)
