WORKING REMOTELY IN MARYLAND

Washington, D.C. has the highest rate of remote workers in the country at 6.1%. The D.C. metropolitan area includes parts of Maryland, Virginia, West Virginia, and the federal district. (WTKR/U.S. Census Bureau)

The annual mean wage in Maryland is \$60,230 or \$28.95 per hour, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics. (BLS, May 2019)

Columbia, Maryland is 23rd among the "Best Cities for Jobs" out of a list of 182 cities from around the country. Baltimore also made the list but further down at spot 160. (WalletHub, Jan. 2020)

In January 2020, Maryland's total unemployment rate was 3.3%, which was lower than the 2019 average U.S. unemployment rate of 3.7%. (BLS Economy at a Glance)

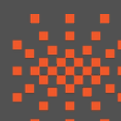
