WORKING REMOTELY IN KANSAS

- ▶ The Choose Topeka incentive program gives qualified workers up to \$15,000 to move to Topeka or Shawnee County communities for a full-time job and rent or buy a home within a year. ([Choose Topeka](#))
- ▶ The annual mean wage in Kansas is \$46,520 or \$22.37 per hour, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics. ([BLS, May 2019](#))
- ▶ Kansas is ranked 7th for Infrastructure and 8th for Natural Environment among all U.S. states. ([U.S. News](#))
- ▶ In January 2020, Kansas's total unemployment rate was 3.1%, which was lower than the 2019 average U.S. unemployment rate of 3.7%. ([BLS Economy at a Glance](#))
