WORKING REMOTELY IN NEW YORK

- New York's state tax laws impose a so-called "telecommuting tax penalty," which is a non-resident personal income tax on a worker's taxable income derived from New York sources. [\(Biglaw Investor, Jan. 2020\)](#)
- The annual mean wage in New York is \$63,970 or \$30.76 per hour, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics. [\(BLS, May 2019\)](#)
- Since 2015, New York has been a top five state for remote jobs, according to Virtual Vocations statistics, both in the number of jobs available within the state and as a popular telework location.
- In January 2020, New York's total unemployment rate was 3.8%, which was higher than the 2019 average U.S. unemployment rate of 3.7%. [\(BLS Economy at a Glance\)](#)
