## WORKING REMOTELY IN NORTH CAROLINA

- The state operates a program that allows agency employees to work from home to promote work efficiencies, competitive advantages, and budgetary and environmental solutions. [\(NC Office of State Human Resources\)](#)
- The annual mean wage in North Carolina is \$48,550 or \$23.34 per hour, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics. [\(BLS, May 2019\)](#)
- Since 2017, North Carolina has been a top 10 state for remote work based on the number of available remote jobs compared to all other states, according to Virtual Vocations statistics.
- In January 2020, North Carolina's total unemployment rate was 3.6% — lower than the 2019 average U.S. unemployment rate of 3.7%. [\(BLS Economy at a Glance\)](#)
