## WORKING REMOTELY IN PENNSYLVANIA

In Pennsylvania, approximately 5.1% of residents work from home.

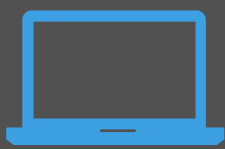
