WORKING REMOTELY IN TEXAS

- Since 2015, Texas has been one of the top five states for remote work, according to Virtual Vocations company statistics.
- The annual mean wage in Texas is \$50,490 or \$24.77 per hour, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics. [\(BLS, May 2019\)](#)
- During 2019, Texas's labor force grew by 342,800 jobs, which is equal to an increase of nearly 1,000 new jobs per day. [\(The Dallas Morning News, Jan. 2020\)](#)
- In January 2020, Texas's total unemployment rate was 3.5%, which was lower than the 2019 average U.S. unemployment rate of 3.7%. [\(BLS Economy at a Glance\)](#)
