## WORKING REMOTELY IN WASHINGTON

- During 2018 and 2019, Washington was a top 15 state for remote jobs, based on company data from Virtual Vocations.
- The annual mean wage in Washington is \$62,020 or \$29.82 per hour, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics. (BLS, May 2019)
- Senate Bill 6016 grants Washington-based businesses up to \$250 in tax credits for each remote employee and a maximum credit of \$10,000 per year for each employee that works remotely at least 12 days out of the month per year. (State of Washington - 65th Legislature)
- In January 2020, Washington's total unemployment rate was 3.9% — higher than the 2019 average U.S. unemployment rate of 3.7%. (BLS Economy at a Glance)
