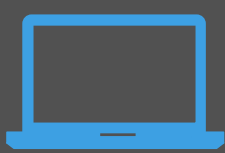

WORKING REMOTELY IN WEST VIRGINIA

- ▶ The Economic Opportunity Tax Credit aims to establish employment opportunities in West Virginia. Some qualifying telecommute-friendly industries include information processing, non-retail goods distribution, qualified research and development, or destination-oriented recreation and tourism. (West Virginia Development Office)
- ▶ The annual mean wage in West Virginia is \$43,420 or \$20.88 per hour, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics. (BLS, May 2019)
- ▶ In January 2020, West Virginia's total unemployment rate was 5.0% — higher than the 2019 average U.S. unemployment rate of 3.7%. (BLS Economy at a Glance)
